# Application Process Guide

Fuel Ventures SEIS / EIS



## Adviser Registration

Register as an adviser on [https://fuel.joinfurther.com/?utm\\_source=titan](https://fuel.joinfurther.com/?utm_source=titan)

(Enter personal details such as personal/organization FCA number.

Check your inbox for a verification email and link to confirm your account.



## Investor Registration

Log in and initiate a new application.

Create a new investor profile (or select their profile from the drop down).

Fill in the investor details and upload an Identity Verification Certificate (IVC) or Confirmation of Verification of Identity (COVI).



## Application

Choose the fund in which the investor wishes to invest.

Specify the investment amount. Input the adviser fee. Submit the details and send the application to the investor for their review and completion.

The investor then receives an email to register for the platform. They will then be asked to review the application, input any additional information and submit the application.



## Confirmation

Both adviser and investor will receive a confirmation email (including application acknowledgement and fund transfer information).



## Deployment

Once funds have been deployed, the adviser & investor will receive a 'Deployment Note' notification from the portal.



## Certificates

When EIS certificates are issued, they are uploaded to the portal and the investor receives direct confirmation. Adviser is notified separately.
